The meeting will discuss options concerning the development of power generation assets currently used by Electric Power Corporation. Part of the meeting includes a visit to the Orakei Marina in Auckland. The meeting also will provide support for EPC in its quest to further develop a sustainable power solution for Samoa as well as helping to find ways for Samoa Ports Authority to better carry out its plans to build new yachting marina in Apia and Salelologa.

General Manager of the Electric Power Corporation, Mua'ausa J Walter and General Manager of Samoa Ports Authority, Toleafoa Elon Betham will accompany the Honourable Minister.
