I thank you for your past support of Samoa. Our people have suffered terrible hardship and loss and you were quick at the time to respond. This has made your willingness to trivialise and obscure our post-Tsunami reconstruction efforts all the more surprising and harmful. I hope that we can find a time in the future where you can take up our offer to show you "where the money has gone".
