1. Tuuina atu Konekarate i le Croxley Stationery NZ Ltd.

Ua faamaonia e le Kapeneta le faatauina mai o meaaoga a Aoga uma a le Malo mo le tausaga 2011, i le Croxley Stationery NZ Ltd.

O lenei tauofoga sa faasalalauina faalaua'itele ma tapunia i le aso 19 Iulai 2010. E lima Kamupani sa tuuina atu tusi talosaga mo lenei tauofoga. Sa iloilo ina nei tusi talosaga e le Soa Komiti e fuafua i aiaiga o le tauofoga ua uma ona faataatitia ma tuuina atu ai loa le faatauina o meaaoga i le Croxley Stationery NZ Ltd.

Croxley Stationery NZ Ltd awarded contract.

Cabinet has approved awarding of contract to Croxley Stationery NZ Ltd for purchasing of Stationeries for all Government Schools for 2011.

The tender for bids was advertised for public interest and was closed on the 19th July 2010. Five Companies submitted applications and was assessed by a Sub-Committee according to conditions and requirements set for the tender. The Croxley Stationery NZ Ltd was considered the most qualified applicant and was awarded the contract.

2. NZ\$50,000 le fesoasoani mo Niu Sila ona o le mafui'e.

Ua faamaonia e le Kapeneta le foa'i atu o se fesoasoani tupe e NZ\$50,000 mo le Malo o Niu Sila ona o mafatiaga ua mafua mai ona o se mafui'e na aafia ai se vaega o lea atunuu.

Ua tolu nei vaiaso talu ona aafia le itumalo o Canterbury i Niu Sila i se mafui'e e tusa ma le 7.1 (fua o le malosiaga o mafui'e - Richter Scale) lona malosi. E leai se tasi na maliu ai ae na faatamaia ai le tele o meatotino ma apitaga o tagata ma le Malo o Niu Sila, faapea ma le siosiomaga o lea atunuu.

O lenei fesoasoani ua faamausali ai sootaga mafanafana ma Feagaiga Vavalalata a le malo Samoa ma le Malo o Niu Sila. Sa tele foi fesoasoani a lea malo na tuuina mai ina ua mafatia Samoa i le galulolo i le tausaga ua mavae.

E tele nisi fesoasoani faapea a le Malo Samoa na tuuina atu i nisi o Malo sa mafatia e i ai Saina, Burma, Fiti, Ausetalia ma Toga.

NZ\$50,000 aid for New Zealand

Cabinet has approved financial assistance of NZ\$50,000.00 for the Government of New Zealand to assist areas of their which was affected by an earthquake that struck part of the country.

The district of Canterbury was struck by a 7.1 Richter Scale earthquake three weeks ago. No deaths were recorded but there was extensive damage to both the individuals and Government properties, and also the environment.

Samoa's aid for New Zealand has again highlighted the Treaty of Friendship between the two countries. New Zealand was in the forefront in assisting Samoa when struck by the tsunami last year.

Samoa has also given aids to other countries like China, Burma, Fiji, Australia and Tonga.

O lenei atiina a'e taua ua laasia e le faigamalo ona o se naunautaiga o le Pulega o Uafu ma Taulaga ina ia toe faaleleia le Uafu i Aleipata mo le faafaigofieina o femalagaaiga i le va o Tutuila ma Samoa, faapea ma le toe fausia o le Nofoga Toso Vaa lea na faatamaia e le galulolo lea na aafia ai Samoa i le aso 29 o Setema 2009.

O le Polokalame ua faataatia mo le aso a taeao o le a tatalaina ai lenei faamoemoe i se saunoaga faafeiloa'i e saunia e le Pule Sili Lagolago a le Pulega o Uafu ma Taulaga, susuga Tua'iaufai Asalemo Tuimauga. O le a taitaia le Sauniga Lotu e faapaia ai le galuega e le Susuga ia Faletui Mulitalo, ma le saunoaga autu o le a saunia e le Afioga i le Palemia, Susuga Tuilaepa Lupesoliai Sailele Malielegaoi. O le Minisita o Galuega, Felauaiga ma Atina'e Tetele, Afioga Tuisugaletaua Sofara Aveau o le a o'otiina le lipine ma Taua'aoina le Tusi Mae'a o le Galuega.

Opening Ceremony of the Aleipata Wharf & Slipway Reconstruction at the Port of Aleipata.

Cabinet has approved the official opening ceremony of the Wharf and Slipway Reconstruction at the Port of Aleipata on Friday, 8 October 2010 at 2.30pm.

The development of this project by Government further highlights the Samoa Ports Authority's focus to rebuild the Aleipata wharf to ease traveling between Tutuila and Samoa, and also to rebuild the slipway damaged by the tsunami of 29 September 2009.

The ceremony will start with welcoming remarks by the Ports Authority's ACEO, Tua'iaufai Asalemo Tuimauga. The Opening Prayer to bless the completion of the work will be lead by Reverend Faletui Mulitalo before the deliverance of the Keynote Address by the Honourable Prime Minister, Tuilaepa Lupesoliai Sailele Malielegaoi. Minister of Works, Transport and Infrastructure, Tuisugaletaua Sofara Aveau will cut the ribbon and Present the Civil Engineering Certificate of Completion of the Wharf.
