The Samoa Rugby Union's first priority will be given to the Rugby 15's Team as our Team prepares for the World Cup which will be held in New Zealand in September/October 2011.

The good results seen in the past years of the performances of our rugby teams have helped market Samoa to the World. This game has helped develop local players and Samoan boys where some have been able to secure contracts with overseas teams.

Cabinet has awarded the contract for the construction of a new Power House at Fiaga to the Bluebird Ah Lal Joint Venture in Association with Mitsubishi Heavy Industries and Woods Pacific.

The whole project includes the design, manufacture, supply, install, test and commission of a 4 diesel generators and construction of Fiaga Power Station.

After assessments by the Tender's Board a recommendation was submitted to Cabinet for approval.
